Plus Three (3) Floater Holidays

As per Standard Sheet Metal Working Agreement, Clause 16 – Holidays and Vacations:

16.01 (a) The recognized **statutory** holidays that shall be observed are New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Victoria Day, Dominion Day (Canada Day), BC Day, Labour Day, Thanksgiving Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

(b) If a Statutory Holiday(s) should fall on a Saturday or a Sunday, either the previous or the following work day(s) shall be observed.

(c) Every worker covered by this Agreement shall be entitled to three (3) additional holidays that shall, with mutual consent not unduly withheld, be observed by giving his employer one (1) week's notice of his intentions. If being understood that job conditions may dictate the particular days these holidays are to be observed (i.e. job sites closed due to construction industry holiday).
